Biden recaptures lost ground

After Hillary Clinton narrowly won Minnesota in 2016, President Donald Trump vowed to flip it red. But despite several campaign stops — and plenty from Joe Biden's camp — the electorate favored the former vice president, delivering him the win in a handful of counties that evaded Clinton. Where Trump prevailed, his win margin was tighter in regional population centers, while it grew in some of the most rural parts of the North Star State.
